



OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

Style 753 HIGH PRESSURE SHUTOFF

The Akron high pressure shutoff is designed to provide superior performance and trouble-free operation for many years. The following operating and maintenance instructions are provided to assist in obtaining the best possible performance from your shutoff.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To open the Shutoff, squeeze the trigger slowly.

CAUTION: Rapid squeezing of the trigger will produce a sudden thrust.

To close the Shutoff, release the trigger slowly.

CAUTION: Rapid release of the trigger may cause water hammer and damage to the hose or other equipment.

CAUTION:

- Maximum Operating Pressure: 50 BAR
- USE WITH HIGH PRESSURE HOSE ONLY
- Avoid directing the stream at personnel.
- Do not use straight jet for electrical fires.
- If used with salt water or foam, flush thoroughly with fresh water after use.

MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

Under normal conditions, periodically flushing the shutoff with clean water and cleaning grit and dirt from around exterior moving parts will allow the shutoff to operate properly.

Eventually it will become necessary to replace the seals. This can be accomplished by purchasing repair parts shown on the Technical Service Parts List.
